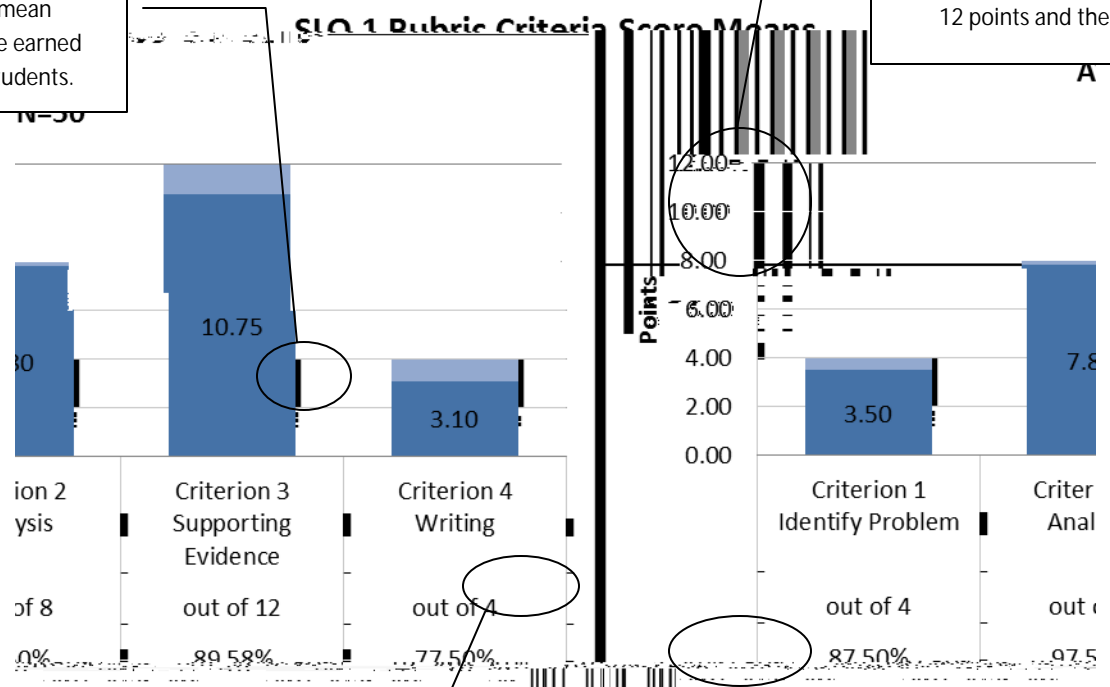
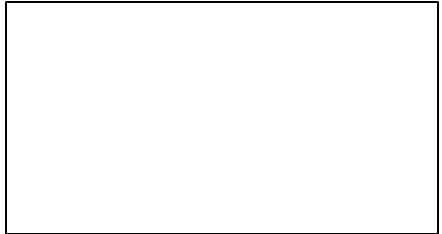


The mean score earned by students.

3. In this case, the maximum score was 12 points and the mean score 10.75.

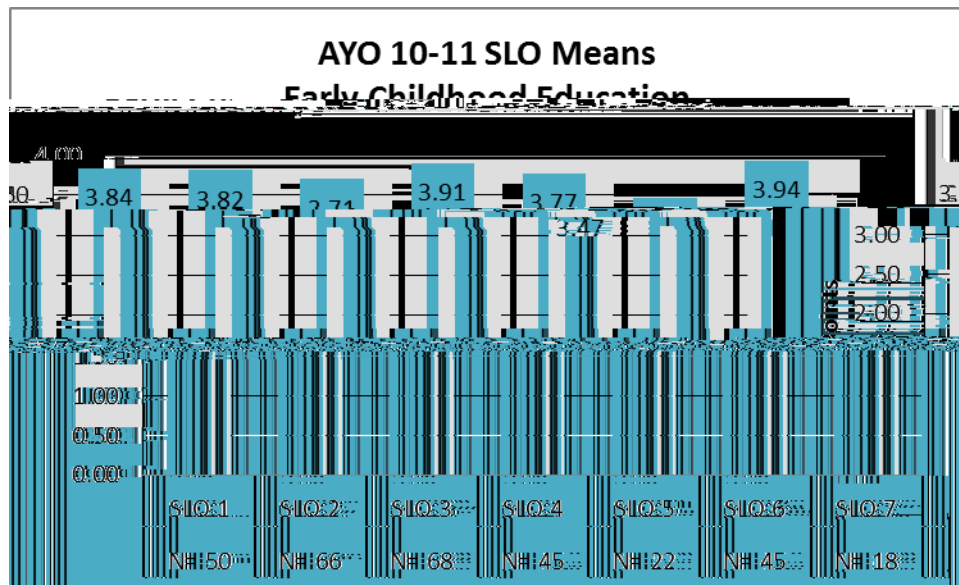
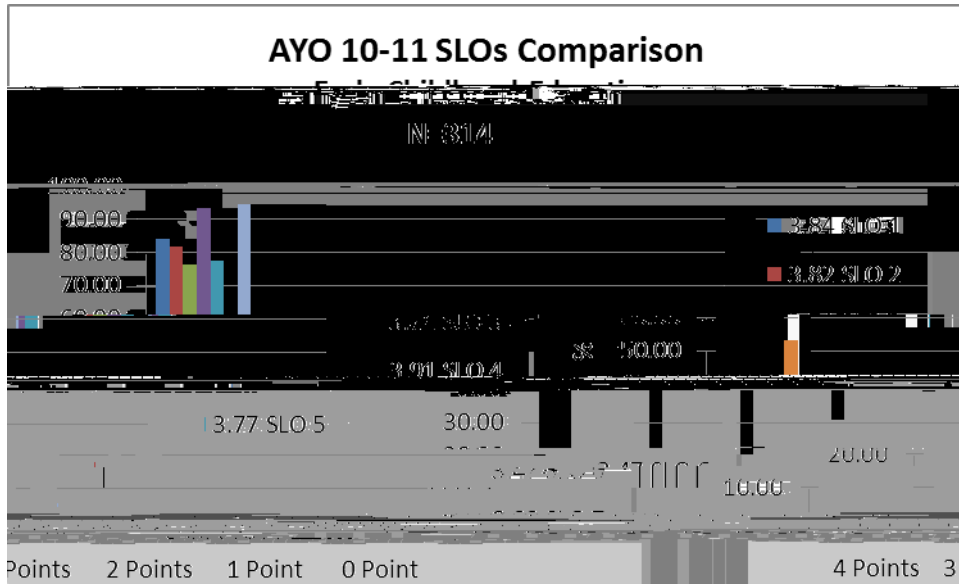


The maximum possible score.



The percentage of the total score attained, on average. In this case:  $10.75 \div 12 = 89.58\%$ . The difference between the mean and the total

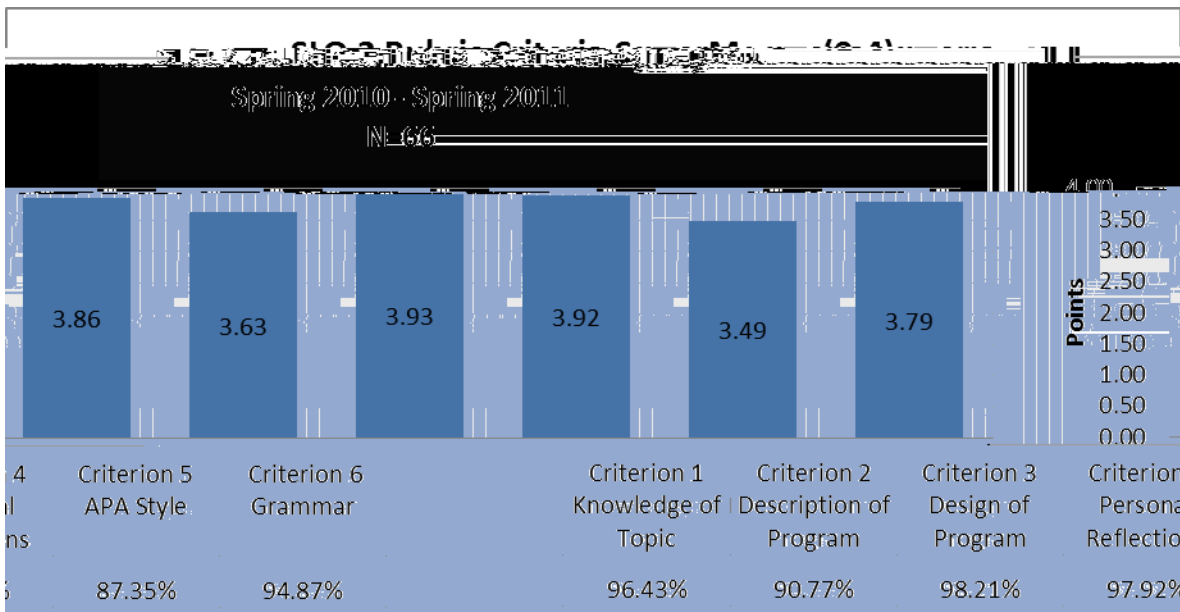
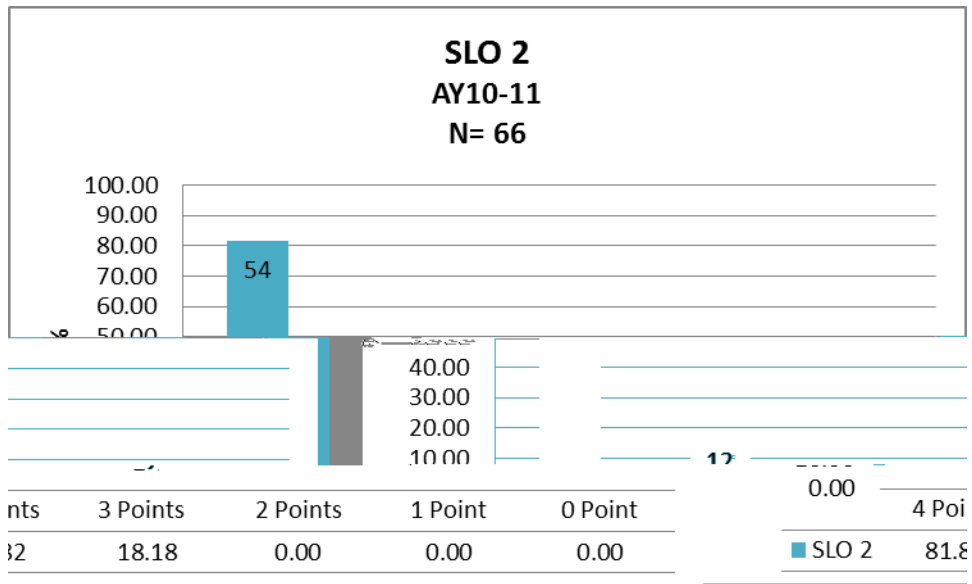
